


## How to search for investments on the Fidelity Platform

If you are looking to find the investment that is right for you, you can use any of our three helpful tools; Navigator, Select 50, or Investment Finder.

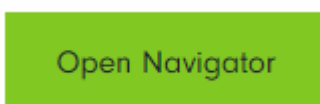
1. Go to [www.fidelity.co.uk](http://www.fidelity.co.uk)
2. Scroll down to 'How would like to invest?' where you will see our 3 different tools, along with a brief description of each.

How would you like to invest?



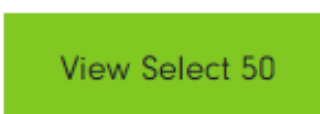
Navigator	Select 50	Investment Finder

3. If you would like to use Navigator, select this option, and click on 'Open Navigator'.



Follow the prompts within Navigator by choosing an investment approach, selecting how you would like your money managed, and choosing your risk level from the options provided

4. If you would like to use the Select 50, select this option, and click on 'View Select 50'.




Scroll down to view the full Select 50 list, or add your own filters to the list under 'Filter the Select 50 funds'. You can also display the list in terms of key components such as 'Performance' or 'Charges'.

5. If you would like to use the Investment Finder, select 'Search for investments'.

## Investment Finder

This will open the 'Investment Finder' page on your screen. Follow the prompts within the tool by selecting an investment type, searching for investments, or filtering your results if relevant.
